

## Gernandt & Danielsson Advokatbyrå KB's Cookie Policy

### 1 Introduction

- 1.1 Gernandt & Danielsson collect information with the help of cookies when you visit our website [www.gda.se](http://www.gda.se). Cookies are small text files which the website you visit requests to store on your computer or equivalent unit with Internet connection.
- 1.2 Cookies are used with the aim of providing a positive user experience on our website and for our commercial interest in obtaining information about the visitors on [www.gda.se](http://www.gda.se). The information created by the cookies, which are placed when you visit our website, includes information such as anonymized IP address, the length of the visit, the number of page viewings, choices made and how you navigated to [www.gda.se](http://www.gda.se).
- 1.3 You choose whether you wish to provide consent to cookies being placed on your computer or other Internet-connected unit. Given consent can be revoked by you at any time. When you visit [www.gda.se](http://www.gda.se), necessary cookies are also placed that do not require your consent.
- 1.4 Gernandt & Danielsson is the personal data controller in respect of the processing of your personal data, which we compile via cookies when you visit our website. For complete information about our processing of personal data, please see our Privacy Policy.

### 2 About cookies

- 2.1 There are two types of cookies: permanent cookies and session cookies. Session cookies are stored temporarily on your computer when you, as a visitor, surf to and on our website. When you close your browser, all session cookies disappear. Permanent cookies remain on your computer until you remove them or the expiry date has passed. Both permanent cookies and session cookies are used on Gernandt & Danielsson's website.
- 2.2 Cookies are also divided into first party cookies and third-party cookies. The proprietor of a website places first party cookies, in this case Gernandt & Danielsson, while someone other than the proprietor of the website places third-party cookies. Only first party cookies are used on Gernandt & Danielsson's website.
- 2.3 In order to be able to evaluate the website's content, structure, navigation, etc. Gernandt & Danielsson uses the statistics tool Matomo Analytics.

This is done in order to be able to develop the website's functions and benefit for the visitor. It is Gernandt & Danielsson who enable cookies (first-party cookies) to collect statistics in accordance with the purpose above and does not disclose the information collected to any third party. - 2.4 In addition, the website includes content and links related to social networks, such as LinkedIn, Facebook and Instagram. Gernandt & Danielsson lacks access to, and cannot control, these cookies or the information, which may be collected. Therefore, you should check these providers' websites in order to obtain more information about how they handle cookies.

### **3 Block or remove cookies**

- 3.1 If you do not wish to allow cookies to be stored on your computer, you can change this in the browser's settings on your computer, and delete cookies that are stored on your storage medium. There is also a possibility to refuse cookies or to choose that a warning be shown before they are stored. The instructions for your web browser or your web browser's help function contain a description of how to do this. - 3.2 If you choose to refuse the cookies that we use on our website, this may result in the website not functioning correctly.

### **4 Cookies on [www.gda.se](http://www.gda.se)**

- 4.1 Different cookies have different purposes. Necessary cookies contain information that we require in order for you to access the website. Function cookies are used to enable us to remember the choices you made when you have previously surfed on our website. Security cookies help to discover fraud or other unlawful access to our website. In addition, analysis cookies provide us with general information, which helps us to make your use as simple as possible or in order to analyse our visitor flows. Finally, there are performance cookies, which ensure that the pages you use are loaded more quickly.

- 4.2 The table below provides a description of the cookies used on Gernandt & Danielsson's website, their function, elimination date and purpose, and whether the information is disclosed to a third party.
